



La Salle Community Fellowship Spring-Summer Intern - 2025

1. Position Description

The Summer Intern position is a temporary position created to provide short-term ministry to La Salle Community Fellowship (LSCF). The Summer Intern will be an individual between the ages of 15-30 (inclusive). The Internship is designed to benefit both LSCF and the Summer Intern. LSCF will benefit from a staff member in training and gifts in the area of church ministry. The Summer Intern will benefit from an opportunity to gain experience and receive leadership training/mentoring in a variety of ministry opportunities as well as to receive constructive feedback to help them grow toward reaching their potential in Christian Service. Specific responsibilities will vary depending on the strengths of the individual.

2. Purpose of the Program

- Encourage, develop, and affirm ministry gifts in individuals
- Provide a broader spectrum of ministry to the congregation and La Salle community during the summer months of 2025

3. Responsibilities

Children's Ministry – Assist ministry to children's programs by providing creative input, planning and assistance as needed for children's ministry over the summer. The Programs include Vacation Bible School (Aug.25-29), and Kidzone (during worship times). Specific tasks may include:

- Assist in planning and leadership with VBS Coordinators for Vacation Bible School
- Leadership of Kidzone program where necessary
- Equip and encourage volunteers in children's ministry

Youth Work - Work closely with the Lead Pastor and Youth Pastor (when present) to cooperate and assist in summer youth ministry. Work with youth and soon-to-be youth is encouraged. Specific tasks may include:

- Organize, plan and execute weekly/bi-weekly youth activities as needed
- Teach, and deliver devotionals to youth
- Seek out and include opportunities for community youth

Worship Service Involvement – Assist the supervisor with planning weekly services and will help coordinate the aspects and the volunteer support required to implement

those services. Involvement will be dependent on the intern's giftings. Musical involvement is also a possibility.

Administrative Duties – As required, the Summer Intern may be asked to organize events, develop proposals, or carry out other administrative projects related to LSCF.

Self-Initiated Project – The Summer Intern is encouraged to bring their own ministry ideas to the Pastors for their approval.

4. Reporting (Supervision, Mentoring, and Accountability)

- Directly to Lead and VBS Coordinators
- Reporting monthly to the Leadership Team
- Summer Intern will be expected to share written work plans for the coming week and report from the previous week (submit timesheet).

5. Evaluation

- Will be solicited from each area of ministry that Summer Worker is involved in or assisted with

- Self-evaluation at the end of the contract
